**Extra classes:** These classes are an optional second class for the dancers. In these classes, we focus on basic technique exercises and applying those exercises to the dancers' steps. In master class, we do a lot of the same exercises but add flexibility, strength and stamina training for the more advanced competitors. We have seen great improvement in the dancers that have done both technique and master classes in the past. The classes are offered to the dancers in the classes next to the class time on the schedule below.

I apologize to the families that are in two separate shows. I tried my best to keep families together. I keep track of the families that are separated and try not to separate them 2 years in a row. For those families that are in two shows, we will provide pizza between shows for you. Please let us know how many people will be attending. Thanks!

**Tickets: NEW THIS YEAR!!!!** Because of the confusion that has occurred in past years before each show, we are going to have assigned seating this year. We are still working out the logistics of this, and a separate e-mail will be sent with details. If anyone has any experience with this process (good or bad), please e-mail me with your comments. We would appreciate any help on this to make it run as smoothly as possible for everyone.

Tickets will go on sale by mid-February. We anticipate that the price of tickets will remain \$7/seat as in the past.

**Costumes for the showcase are:**

**Girls wearing school costumes:**

1. **Dresses or jumpers** – Please be sure to try your costume on and make sure it fits. We are having the last merchandise sale before the Showcase on Sunday, February 28 from 1:00-3:30.
2. **Short-sleeve Peter Pan collar blouses** – You need these with the jumper. These can be found in the Penney's catalog or any uniform store.
3. **Shoes** – Ghillies are needed for all classes. If you need a pair, you can order them at a variety of places on-line. We suggest [www.rutherfordshoes.com](http://www.rutherfordshoes.com).
4. **Poodle Socks** - All girls will need poodle socks. The Boosters purchased a quantity of socks and will have them available for sale once the shipment arrives. We anticipate them to arrive the week of February 8. The price is \$7.50 for Booster members and \$9.00 for non-members.
5. **Spankies** - All girls need white spankies (these are like cheerleading trunks). They can be found at most dance stores and at Dicks or other sporting goods stores.
6. **Hair** - The most recent wig order has been placed with our supplier, but we will be doing one last one before the Showcase. The deadline for this order coincides with the dress sale Sunday, February 28. You can find the form on the Students page of our website – [www.bellschool.com](http://www.bellschool.com).
7. **Tiaras** – All girls will need a tiara. They can be purchased through the Boosters.
  - Girls with scrunchie need a small tiara (in stock, \$8 – member, \$10 – non-member)
  - Girls with any of the “larger” wigs need an embroidered headband (in stock, \$25 – member, \$30 non-member)

**Boys wearing school costumes:**

1. **Blue Tie** – These can be ordered on the same form as the dresses, jumpers and headbands. These forms can be found at the studio or on our website.
2. **Black slacks** – All boys will need black slacks without cuffs.
3. **Black shirt** – All boys will need a black long sleeved dress shirt.
4. **Shoes** – All boys will need jazz shoes.

**Classes wearing solo costumes have been notified in class.**

**Photographs:** Pictures for the Showcase will be taken once again during dress rehearsal. Forms will be at the studio in early March.

**Volunteers:** We will be asking for volunteers for help at the rehearsal and actual Showcase in many areas. We will have sign-up sheets at the studio in March. Any help is appreciated. You don't have to work both shows. There are enough parents that if you can only work one shift than that would be fine. Look for the sign-up sheets next month. And thank you in advance for any time you can give.

**Flowers** will once again be offered for sale. Just as last year we will be giving tickets for a free bunch of flowers for each Booster member dancer. Others can be purchased at a cost of \$7.00 per bunch.

**Video:** You are NOT allowed to take flash photography or videotape the show. (You may however video the dress rehearsal.) A professional video will be available. Marince Associates will be at both the dress rehearsal and the Showcase and will produce a multi-camera shoot of the event. Order forms will be available soon. You can order the video

before and after the show; however, it will be advantageous to order before the show as the price will be higher after.

**Food and drinks are not permitted in the building. Water will be provided for the dancers backstage.**

### **Procedures for both Rehearsal and Showcase:**

To ensure that the upcoming Showcase is a success, we are asking that everyone please show consideration to the dancers and their families by adhering to the procedures outlined below. We ask for your support for the volunteers who are providing an enjoyable and orderly show for all.

**You will soon receive information from your Class Leader regarding your class' meeting place for the Dress Rehearsal and Showcase. Please be sure to check your e-mail.** These will also be posted in the lobby of the middle school outside the auditorium.

There will be three (3) rooms utilized for dancers to wait during the show. This will help facilitate the release of dancers after the show.

Please arrive dressed and ready to go at your assigned place and time. This is extremely important because the Dress Rehearsal and Showcase can't start until all the dancers have arrived. Remember, there are others relying on your child and the dancers have worked hard to prepare for the show.

No parents are allowed in any of the holding rooms. If your child needs assistance getting ready, please take them to the restroom before entering their assigned room. These rooms are extremely crowded with dancers, at times trying to get changed into their dresses, please be respectful of their privacy and leave your dancer at the door.

Make-up is only permitted on dancers 12 and older or dancers wearing solo dresses. If a child who is not permitted is wearing make-up they will be asked to remove it. This is extremely embarrassing for the dancers, so please don't allow it to become an issue.

No food or drinks will be allowed in the holding rooms or the auditorium. In the past, there have been beverage spills and garbage left for others to clean up.

During the show, please be considerate to those around you by not standing up or leaving in-between dances. There will be no entering or exiting the large doors in the back of the auditorium once the show has started. These doors will not be opened during the show. If you must leave the show, please exit only through the side back doors.

All dancers must check in and out with their Class Leader at their assigned meeting place. This is to ensure the safety of all the dancers and guarantee everyone is accounted for.

Group and individual pictures will be taken at the Dress Rehearsal. Once your dancer has completed their dances and had their class pictures taken they may leave the Dress Rehearsal after checking out with their Class Leader.

No dancers will be released until the show is over. Please do not come to the doors of the holding rooms requesting your child until the end of the show. While we understand that they are your children and you may want to take them after their last dance, the confusion and chaos this creates is extreme: parents getting up and leaving the show while others are trying to watch their dancer, parents congregating around the doors while we're trying

to move dancers in and out of the room to the stage, and searching for an individual dancer while trying to manage hundreds of others.

## **ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE**

There are many details included below. Thank you in advance for your attention to these details. We will have a very large group in the parade and everyone's cooperation is necessary.

- 1. Meeting Time:** Parade begins at **10:00 AM on Saturday, March 13.** All participants must report in uniform no later than **9:30 AM** at our meeting location. The reason for the early time is that once the parade begins, it is nearly impossible to get into town and park.
- 2. Meeting Location:** We have not received our specific number assignment yet , but will post it at the studio and one our website and send it via e-mail as soon as we receive it. All participants **MUST** check in with their assigned **CLASS LEADER** upon arrival. Each class leader will have a sign with the class name on it, and a flag with the class colors.
- 3. Uniform:** The uniform is as follows: **white** turtleneck, Bell School sweatshirt, and black pants. You will be told in class what color shoes to wear – black or white. All adults can wear black or white shoes. **New this year:** As mentioned in previous memos and e-mails, a ski headband with our embroidered logo on it is now part of the required uniform. These have been ordered in quantity and will be distributed through your class leader. **There is no order form necessary!** Prices are as follows: Booster member dancers – FREE (as a token of our appreciation for your membership and support), Booster member non-dancer - \$8, ALL Non-Booster members - \$10. **Please remember that any parent or child who is not wearing the designated uniform cannot march in the parade.** They may follow the group along the sidewalk, but not in the ranks. **There will be no exceptions made.**
- 4. Sweatshirts:** The order for sweatshirts has been placed with the embroiderer. Be on the lookout for notification of their arrival.
- 5. Check Out:** The end of the parade can be very confusing. For this reason, children **MUST** stay in their groups until their parent or guardian has checked them out with the group leader. **There will be no exceptions.** This way, we can make sure that your child is **SAFE.**

The main responsibilities include emailing information to parents, supervision of dancers during Showcase weekend and the St. Patrick's Day Parade.

In addition, for the classes with younger dancers it is best to have 2 class leaders to help with supervision/security. The following classes have 1 volunteer but we still need a second person: Offaly, Limerick, and Donegal.
